Recommendations from EPEP Team

- Seek vendor support to address technical issues
- Use EMR preventive care report
- Use reminder/alerts in proactive manner
- Immunization workflow
- Use of population-based reports to plan for follow-up or suspected Dx
- Use flowsheets for chronic disease management and prevention/screening
- Nomenclature management

Data Quality Results

| Data Quality Indicator | Post-EPEP Engagement Improvement |
|--|----------------------------------|
| Cervical screening (per 12-month period) | 22% |
| Problem list error rate (Diabetes) | 37% |
| Patients with high HbA1C while no Dx | 9% |
| Diabetes follow-up visits (per quarter) | 10x |

Recommendations from EPEP Team

- Roster reconciliation
- Use EMR preventive care report
- Review and implement preventive care workflows
- Use reminder/alerts in a proactive manner
- Nomenclature management: smoking status tools and data entry workflow
- Use population-based reports to plan for follow-up or suspected Dx

Data Quality Results

| Data Quality Indicator | Post-EPEP Engagement Improvement * |
|--|------------------------------------|
| Childhood immunizations | 34% |
| Flu vaccinations | 16% |
| Cervical screenings | 10% |
| Suspected Diabetes with no diagnosis in problem list | 53% |
| Roster status variance (MOH vs EMR) | 32% |
| Smoking status completeness in CPP | Up to 16% |
