Regarding:	Receiving Grey Bruce Health Services, Hanover and District Hospital and South Bruce Grey Health Centre medical records via Hospital Report Manager (HRM)

Grey Bruce Health Services (GBHS), Hanover and District Hospital (HDH) and South Bruce Grey Health Centre (SBGHC) have all integrated their data to OntarioMD's Hospital Report Manager (HRM), a method of distribution which electronically delivers medical records directly into the patients' chart, within the primary care EMR (Electronic Medical Record).

If you have enrolled to HRM, you will continue to receive medical records via both your current delivery method (SPIRE, fax or mail) **and** by HRM until a request is received by email to discontinue the delivery of medical records via your current delivery method. **If you are a current SPIRE subscriber, you can continue to receive your patients' lab results via SPIRE.**

Send an email to [<mailto:hl7@gbhs.on.ca>] requesting the discontinuation of medical records via your current delivery method. You must include your First Name, Last Name, CPSO Number and City in your email. Once received, we will update your distribution information to receive medical record results only via HRM.

Important: Please do not transmit any Personal Health Information using this email address. If you have an inquiry specific to a particular document, please provide the document ID number.
